GENERAL CONDITIONS

RULES: The Show is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society Incorporated and the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies.

SAFETY AND SECURITY: The Society takes all reasonable care in these matters. Please refer to the following "Notice to Ground Users", and the Safety Regulations listed therein. The Society engages the services of Security Personnel to assist with the provision of care of all exhibits, livestock and property, but no responsibility can be accepted for loss or damage to or by such exhibits, livestock and / or property.

WAIVER: Every person that is involved in an activity during the Show is required by our insurer to sign a waiver. This includes riders, volunteers, trade exhibitors, entertainers etc.

LOST PERSONS: "Lost" persons, or those seeking "lost" persons are asked to wait on the roadside outside the Police Room. Public Address announcements will be made as deemed necessary.

EARLY ENTRIES: The lodgement of early entry forms for all Sections of the Show (except the Ring events where entries can be "on the day") will greatly assist Stewards and Office staff in the smooth running of the Show.

DATES: Please note that dates quoted in this Schedule, e.g. 20th May, 30th June, refer to the year of this Show. As per dates on the front page of this Schedule.

NOTICE TO GROUND USERS: The duration of the 2018 Show includes set up time pre-Show and pack-up post -Show. (The period 8th June to 20th June 2018 inclusive)

SAFETY REGULATIONS: This is a Safety Conscious Show and it is your Show. Please help to keep it safe and accident free. Normal rules and regulations of the Workplace Health and Safety Act, Sunshine Coast Council and the Show Society apply.

The Society requests the total co-operation of all Exhibitors, Competitors and Patrons in the following matters as these are requirements of our insurers and / or the Showground Management for the duration of the 2018 Sunshine Coast Show.

1. Your co-operation is sought in reporting to the Show Safety Officer or Show Manager any situation you may consider a potential hazard or danger.
2. The Show Safety Officer, or Nominee, has the power to instruct any Ground User to comply with the Society's requirements at all times.
3. All heavy vehicles and floats must be parked in designated areas as directed by parking stewards. Owners / drivers are reminded that offenders of this requirement and those who indulge in excessive speed could be responsible for serious consequences in the event of an emergency.
4. Whilst all reasonable care is taken, the Society cannot accept any responsibility for any losses of, or damage or injury to or by, any livestock, exhibits, equipment, vehicles or any other property.
5. Trade exhibitors are asked to note that set-up is not to commence before Thursday, 14th June and all exhibits and related display equipment, trailers, buildings, etc. must be removed from the grounds by Tuesday, 19th June at the latest.
6. The Trade Chief Steward will oversee Trade Exhibitors who are also asked to take all reasonable care in the case of working machinery, hydraulics, cables, chemicals, pumps, hoses, pools, power tools, saws, ramps, etc. All electrical leads and appliances must meet Workplace Health and Safety standards, in particular the requirement for all leads to be buried 75mm underground or be at least 2 metres aboveground. All electrical equipment that comes onto the grounds must have a current test and tag label attached or the equipment

cannot be used. These requirements will be monitored by the District Workplace Health and Safety inspector.

7. Dogs are **not** permitted in the Showgrounds at any time unless it is a Guide or Companion Dog. Any dog found will be impounded as per Council regulations.
8. Government regulations re Smoking
 - no-smoking in commercial outdoor eating or drinking areas
 - no-smoking in outdoor public places such as patrolled beaches, children's playground equipment, major sport stadiums and within 4 metres of non-residential building entrances
 - no sales of tobacco products to children under 18 years of age
 - mandatory no-smoking and quit smoking signs
 - no tobacco advertising or competitions
 - **To comply with these regulations there will be no smoking on the grounds other than in signed designated areas set aside specifically for smoking.**

SHOW MEMBERSHIP: Adult Membership is open to anyone with the annual Fee being set at \$40.00 per person which is due to be paid by 31st March 2018. Junior Memberships are also available for anyone under the age of 18 years (as at the date of the 2018 Show) with the Annual Fee being set at \$15.00 per person.

- ✚ Voting rights at any General Meeting and the Annual General Meeting;
- ✚ One (1) car pass for the duration of the Show;
- ✚ One (1) Guest Pass for the duration of the Show

A Junior Membership will entitle you to:

- ✚ Unlimited access to the Show;
- ✚ Reduced entry fees for all Sections

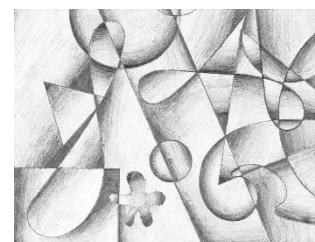

PLEASE READ SCHEDULE CAREFULLY

CONDITIONS:

1. Spiral Inc is the co-ordinator and organising body for the Art Section.
2. Entry Forms, Payment and All Art MUST be received by Friday 8th June 2018.
3. All Exhibits to be delivered to the Main Pavilion on the Showgrounds on Monday 11th June between 9.00am and 12 noon.
4. All Freighted entries are to be addressed as follows: Jasmine Bethell, Sunshine Coast Show Spiral's Art Show, Nambour Showgrounds, Coronation Avenue, Nambour Qld 4560: HOLD AT SHOW OFFICE FOR COLLECTION.
5. Freighted works must arrive no later than Tuesday 5th June 2018. All expenses in conjunction with forwarding, packing, repacking, returning and insurance of entries shall be borne by the competitor.
6. The Organizers accept no responsibility for loss or damage. It is recommended that all artists undertake their own insurance.
7. All decisions regarding the Arts Festival will be the ultimate responsibility of the Organizers and no further discussion will be entered into.
8. All paintings **must be the original work of the exhibitor and not previously won an award.**
9. All works must be suitable for general public exhibition.
10. Paintings must be suitably framed and ready to hang with cord or wire on 'D' hooks and must not exceed 1 metre in width or height, including frame, or 1.5 metres for Class 1 – No fishing line to be used.
11. All entries will need to be transported up a flight of stairs by the exhibitor.
12. Class Tickets will be provided to each exhibitor upon delivery of their exhibits to the show. Class Tickets MUST be fixed to the front right hand corner of each painting.
13. Title: Medium: Class: Price: Name and Phone Number of Artist are to be clearly printed on the back/underneath each piece of work (or will not be accepted).
14. Works can be for sale, but not a requirement. Prices must be in whole dollars and include GST and a 25% Commission, which will be donated to Spiral to assist in the Transport Program to ensure our people can access the Sunshine Coast. Payment for works sold or acquired will be bank transferred approximately four (4) weeks after the close of the Show.
15. All entries will be judged and the decision of the judge/s shall be final and binding. If works are considered to be of insufficient standard, first prize may not be awarded.
16. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will works be accepted for Judging after Monday 11th June, 2018.
17. Works must be collected between 9.00am to 12 noon on Monday 18th June 2017. The Class Ticket Stub MUST be presented as ID. Uncollected works will become the property of Spiral Inc and will be disposed of at their discretion after one (1) month.
18. Prize and Awards will be presented at the Opening Night on Thursday 14th June 2018 in the Main Pavilion 6.30pm for a 7.00pm start. All are welcome.

19. All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits but the Society/Co-ordinators will accept no liability for loss or damage.

20. Exhibitors' submission of entry implies acceptance of all conditions as listed. The Society/Co-ordinators reserve the right to reproduce any pictures of work in the press or on TV. The signed entry form is evidence of the Artist's consent.

21. To ensure local artists get a chance to exhibit, a maximum of 3 class can be entered into.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize Money will be bank transferred by the Spiral Inc Accounts Officer after the event. All prize money unclaimed by 31st July 2018 will be forfeited to Spiral as a donation. Artists who sell their art piece/s will need to provide Spiral with bank account details before a transfer can be conducted.

DISCLAIMER: The Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society (SCASS) shall not be responsible for any accident that may be caused to or by an exhibitor, members of the general public or competitor and will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for any losses or non-delivery of livestock or entries of any kind, or any injury or damage done thereby. Persons contravening any of SCASS's rules/regulations shall forfeit any prize awarded. SCASS reserves the right to refuse or cancel, or require any entry to be removed at any time. Exhibitors shall accept the decision of the Stewards/Judges appointed by SCASS as final. **The decisions of the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society Committee are final.**
